- <u>Start your Job/Internship Search</u>


FINANCIAL AID (ONE MORE TIME....)

It STILL isn't too late to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2020/2021 Academic Year! The FAFSA does not impact and is not impacted by VA Education Benefits. Consider it a security blanket for educational expenses – you may even qualify for grants that don't have to be repaid! Visit <u>fafsa.gov</u> to complete the FAFSA.

Please note: The 2020/2021 FAFSA will use your 2018 income information in the determination of your eligibility for aid. However, if your 2018 income was at least 25% higher than what you will make in 2020, you can request a recalculation of your 2020/2021 financial aid eligibility, potentially increasing your eligibility for grants.
